

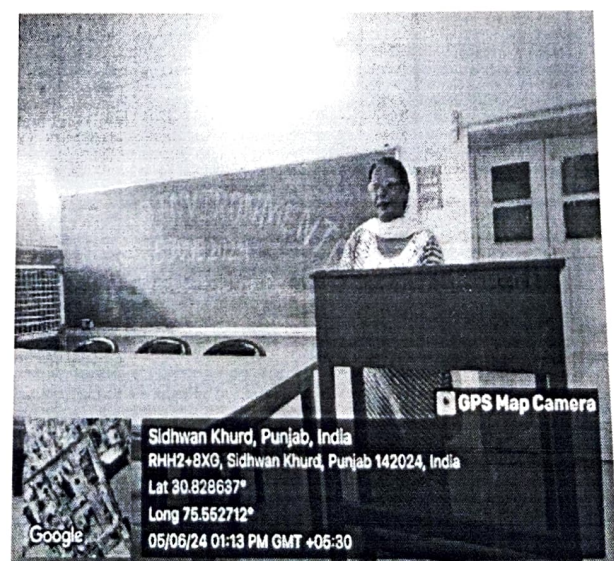

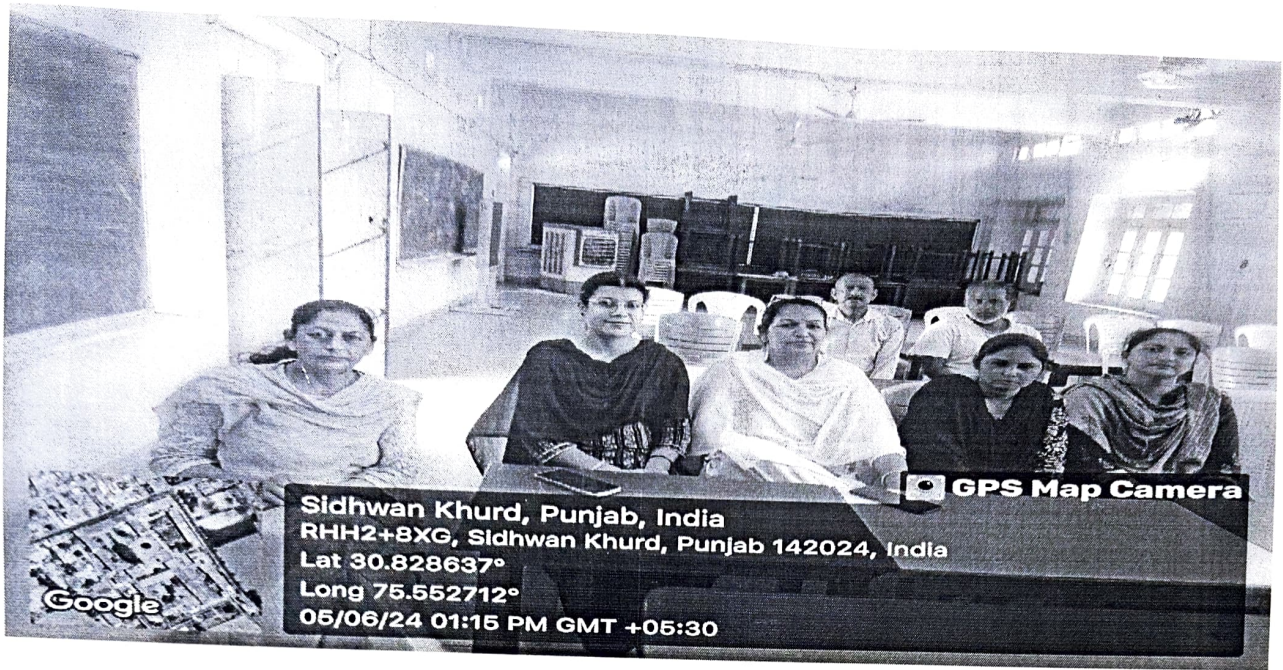
Report of World Environment Day Celebration
